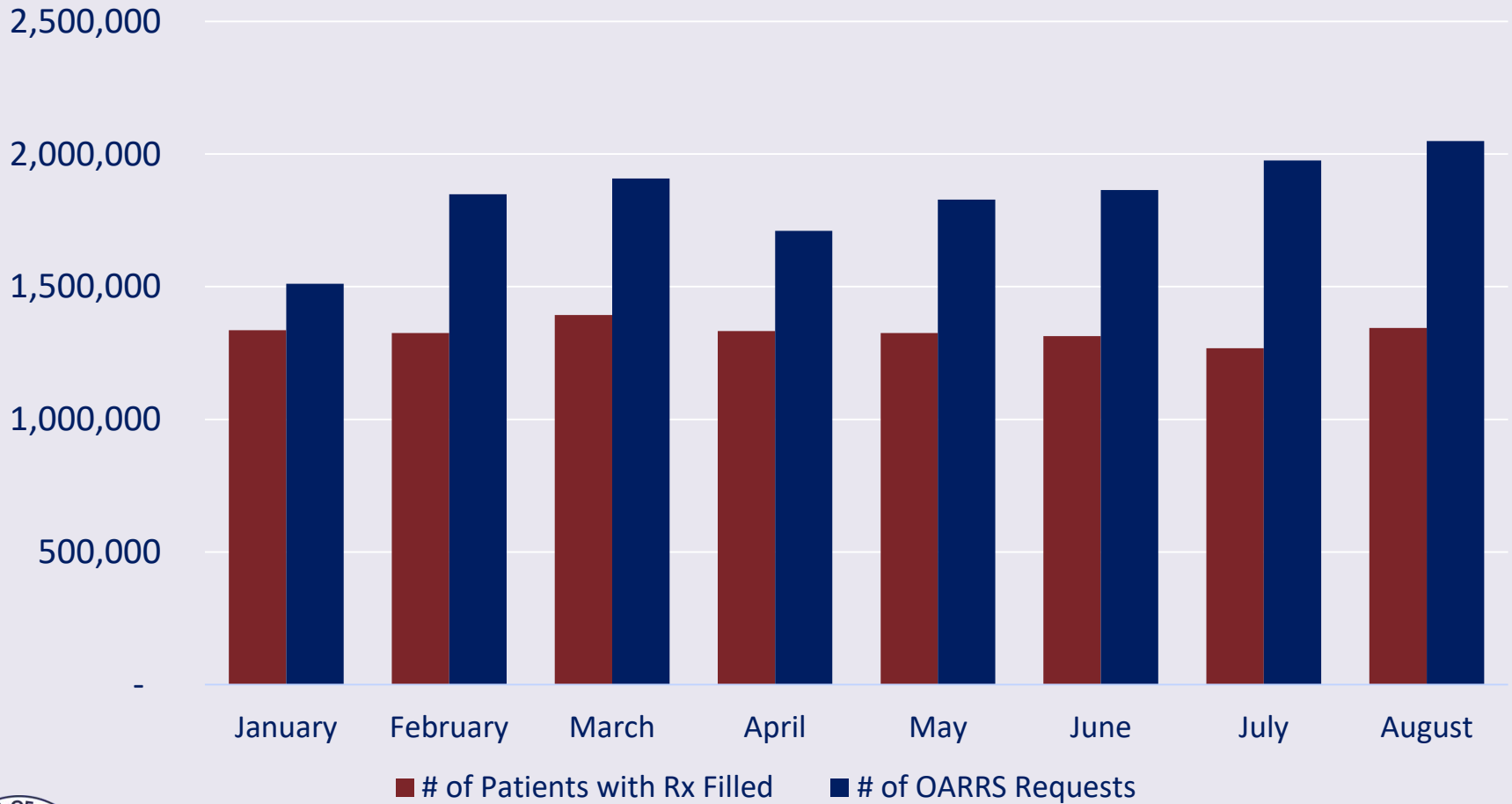

| # of Patients not checked         | 1     | 2-5   | 6-50  | 51+   |
|-----------------------------------|-------|-------|-------|-------|
| Dentists                          | 409   | 154   | 43    | 1     |
| Physicians & Physician Assistants | 3,423 | 4,490 | 6,491 | 2,164 |
| Advanced Practice Nurses          | 564   | 815   | 1,050 | 102   |



# Ohio's Mandatory Use Law

A prescriber must check OARRS if:

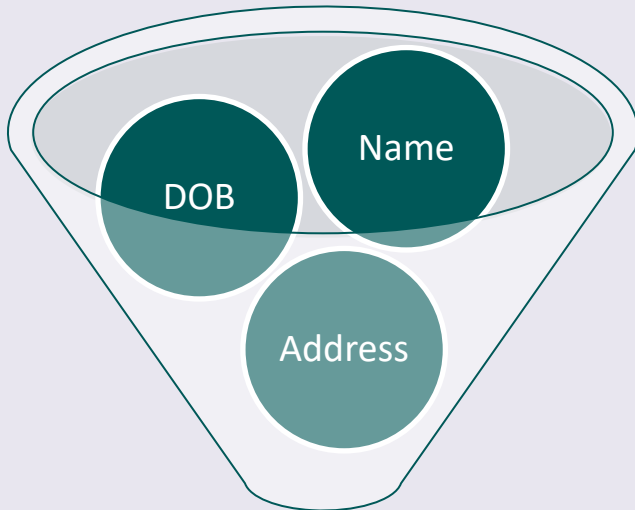
1. Prescribing an opioid or a benzodiazepine; AND
2. More than 7 days; AND
3. Not hospice, end of life care or treating cancer; AND
4. Not immediately following surgery



# How to Monitor Compliance

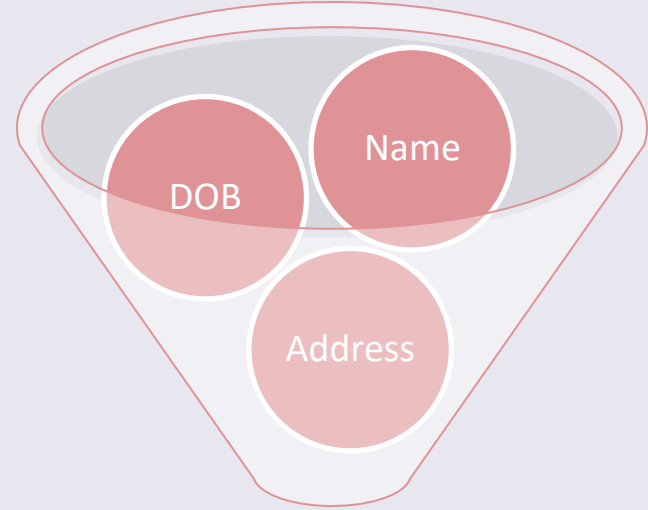
## Step 1 – Recognize that Request = Patient

# How to Monitor Compliance

## Step 2 – Recognize that Prescriber = User

- DEA Number
- NPI Number
- Professional License Number

### User

- Name
- DEA Number
- NPI Number
- Professional License Number



# How to Monitor Compliance

Step 3 – Determine how often you want to report compliance

Step 4 – Get updated data from various systems

- PMP Registration
- PMP Prescriptions
- PMP Requests
- PMP Patients
- PMP Prescribers
- Licensing Board Registrations





# How to Monitor Compliance

## Step 5 – Reprocess requests

## Step 6 – Create Reporting Dataset

- Prescriber DEA
- Prescriber Professional License #
- Licensing Board
- Patient
- Date Rx Written
- PMP Checked within previous x days?

## Step 7 – Generate Report



# Not So Fast...

## Potential Complications

- Prescriber has multiple DEA #'s
- Prescriber licensed by multiple boards
- Pharmacy entered the wrong DEA #
- Delegates
- Non-delegates
- Exceptions to mandatory use laws
- Faulty/insufficient data at registration, licensing, DEA, etc.





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
