Enrollment Mandates

Dispenser - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment

Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment

Effective Date(s): July 17, 2017; May 16, 2020; March 7, 2021; May 6, 2021

Details:

Registration with the prescription drug monitoring program controlled substance prescription database. (a) A prescriber shall register with the PDMP within 30 days after the date of initial licensure or registration with the federal Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), whichever is later. (b) A licensed pharmacist practicing in this state shall register with the prescription drug monitoring program's controlled substance prescription database (PDMP). Registration must be completed within 30 days of initial licensure if the pharmacist's practice is expected to involve [BEFORE] dispensing a schedule II, III, or IV controlled substance under federal law. If not dispensing in this state, a pharmacist must submit a PDMP dispensation exemption form provided by the board within 30 days of initial licensure. A pharmacist who submitted a dispensation exemption form must register before dispensing a schedule II, III, or IV controlled substance under federal law in this state.

Use Mandates

Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Use

Effective Date(s): July 17, 2017; December 28, 2022

Details:

Requires adoption of regulations that provide that a practitioner query the PDMP prior to dispensing, prescribing, or administering a Sch. II or III controlled substance; query is not required for patients receiving treatment in an inpatient setting, at the scene of an emergency or in an ambulance, in an emergency room, immediately before, during or within the first 48 hours after surgery or a medical procedure, in a hospice or nursing home that has an in-house pharmacy, or a non-refillable prescription in a quantity intended to last not more than three days.

52.865. Reporting and reviewing PDMP information. (h) Unless excused from reviewing the PDMP under AS 17.30.200(k)(4)(A) - (B), a practitioner, but not a pharmacist, must review the information in the PDMP to check a patient's prescription records before dispensing, prescribing, or administering a schedule II or III controlled substance under federal law.
