### **Use Mandates**

Dispenser - Mandatory PDMP Use Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Use

Effective Date(s): June 23, 2017 (medical marijuana); July 1, 2018 (for all prescribers and dispensers)

#### Details:

Effective July 1, 2018, a prescriber must query the PDMP database prior to prescribing a controlled substance in schedules II-V. Effective July 1, 2018, a dispenser must query the PDMP database prior to dispensing a controlled substance in schedules II-V. Provides that a qualified physician may issue a physician certification for the medical use of marijuana only if the physician has reviewed the patient's controlled drug prescription history in the PMP.
