A prescriber, or licensed health care practitioner duly authorized by a prescriber, shall, before writing a prescription for a controlled substance listen in Schedule II, III, IV, or V for a patient, obtain a patient utilization report regarding the patient for the preceding twelve (12) months from the computerized program established by the Department pursuant to § 67.301(a) of Title 9 Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 67, if the prescriber has a reasonable belief that the patient may be seeking the controlled substance, in whole or in part, for any reason other than the treating of an existing medical condition and: (1) the patient is a new patient of the prescriber, or (2) The patient has not received any prescription for a controlled substance from the prescriber in the preceding twelve (12) months.
