All prescribers with an Idaho Controlled Substance Registration must have an account with the PDMP. All Idaho licensed pharmacists must have an account with the PDMP.

Use Mandates

Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Use

Effective Date(s): July 1, 2020

Details:

Prior to issuing to a patient a prescription for outpatient use for an opioid analgesic or benzodiazepine listed in Schedule II, III or IV, the prescriber or prescriber's delegate shall review the patient's prescription drug history for the preceding twelve months from the PDMP and evaluate the data for indicators of prescription drug diversion or misuse.
