### **Enrollment Mandates**

Dispenser - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment

Effective Date(s): October 1, 2016 (must register by July 1, 2017)

#### Details:

Practitioners legally authorized to prescribe CDS in Maryland (with or without their own individual DEA and state-level CDS registrations). Dispensers in possession of an active Maryland pharmacist license

### **Use Mandates**

Effective Date(s): July 1, 2018

#### Details:

Starting 7/1/2018, when prescribing a new course of treatment with an opioid or benzodiazepine, and if that course of treatment continues, at least every 90 days after. Starting 7/1/2018, when dispensing ANY CDS prescription, if they have reason to believe the prescription is being filled for something other than a legitimate medical diagnosis (corresponding responsibility under federal regulations).
