### **Enrollment Mandates**

Dispenser - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment

Effective Date(s): March 27, 2018 (statute; practitioners must register by July 1, 2018); April 5, 2018 (regulation)

#### Details:

Prescribes with Oregon licensure and active DEA. Dispensers - Exemptions include: state and federal correctional facility pharmacies, inpatient pharmacies (hospital, in-patient care facilities), Long Term Care pharmacies, student health center pharmacies, pharmacies dispensing fewer than 16 prescriptions annually (with waiver), pharmacies not licensed to dispense CS.

### **Use Mandates**

Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Use

Effective Date(s): October 1, 2021

#### Details:

Pharmacists with authority to prescribe pseudoephedrine products must query the PDMP prior to issuing such a prescription.

OAR 410-120-1260

- (13) Enrolled providers are required to check the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP), as defined in ORS 431A.655, before prescribing a schedule II controlled substance pursuant to 42 USC 1396w-3a.
- (a) Providers shall maintain documentation of the prescription drug history of the individual being treated; and
- (b) In the case that an enrolled provider is not able to conduct the PDMP check, the providers shall maintain documentation of

efforts, including reasons why the provider was unable to conduct the check.

- (c) The PDMP check does not apply to clients in exempt populations:
- (A) Individuals receiving hospice care;
- (B) Individuals receiving palliative care;
- (C) Individuals receiving cancer treatment;
- (D) Individuals with sickle cell disease; and
- (E) Residents of long-term care facilities described in 42 USC 1396a(oo)(3)(A)(ii).
- (d) PDMP requirements are in accordance with OAR 333-023-0800 to 333-023-0830.
