System query.-- \(1\) A dispenser shall query the system before dispensing an opioid drug product or a benzodiazepine prescribed to a patient if any of the following apply: \(i\) The patient is a new patient of the dispenser. \(ii\) The patient pays cash when they have insurance. \(iii\) The patient requests a refill early. \(iv\) The patient is getting opioid drug products or benzodiazepines from more than one prescriber. \(2\) For the purposes of this subsection, a new patient does not include an individual going to the same pharmacy, or a different physical location of that pharmacy, if the patient's record is available to the dispenser. \(\(e\) added Nov. 2, 2016, P.L.980, No.124\)](#)
