BJA Category 2

Pennsylvania's Objectives:

- ▀ Ensure data quality and integrity
- ▀ Create and enforce access rules that determine under what circumstances certain data can be made available
- ▀ Identify the differences in the various PDMP procedures, rules, state regulations, capabilities, and policies to assist with role management and access
- ▀ Produce data reports and analysis

- Analyze Prescriber/Dispenser/Pharmacy identifiers

- Pennsylvania uses NPI to determine uniqueness for providers/pharmacies
- Pennsylvania also collects DEA numbers and Pennsylvania professional license number
- Pennsylvania does not currently validate these numbers match.
- Goals:
 - Identify which identifier is best for data analysis (publications.)
 - Identify errors in pharmacy submission of these fields/best practices for fixing the errors.

- Analyze non required and situational fields

- Pennsylvania last updated reporting requirements in 2019 by adding three fields
- Currently requires reporting in ASAP 4.2
- Data submitters are using newer ASAP versions to submit data
- Goals:
 - Review data already being submitted to the PA PDMP in newer ASAP versions
 - Determine feasibility transition to newer ASAP versions and/or add more required fields

Create and enforce access rules that determine under what circumstances certain data can be made available

- Enhance Registration process:
 - PA Act 191 of 2014 includes access to PDMP data for non-medical individuals, including (but not limited to):
 - Law enforcement
 - Department of State
 - Managed Care Organizations
 - Medical Marijuana Office
 - Medical Examiners/Coroners
 - Logicoy, PA's PDMP vendor, designed a robust and highly customizable category/role system allowing for easy new role creations
 - Currently, Pennsylvania manually registers non-medical users and requires each organization to establish a single point-of-contact for registration requests

- Add PDMP roles to augment the oversight of non-prescriber and non-dispenser account administration
 - ▣ Allow role “supervisors” to register their organization’s users
 - ▣ Provide supervisors a link to their specific registration page
 - ▣ Supervisors will also be able to perform role administration, including revoking access of their users.

Produce data reports and analysis

- Hire and onboard an Epidemiologist Research Assistant (ERA) to research best practices in data collection for future data analysis
 - Aid in the day-to-day data analysis
 - Help Compliance officer determine new and innovate ways to find errors
 - Mismatch of prescriber identifiers
 - Possible incorrect NDCs
- Analysis results are submitted for publication in peer-reviewed journals, presented at national conferences, and/or disseminated to the public via data briefs and reports.
