Effective Date(s): June 23, 2017 (medical marijuana); July 1, 2018 (for all prescribers and dispensers)

Effective July 1, 2018, a prescriber must query the PDMP database prior to prescribing a controlled substance in schedules II-V. Effective July 1, 2018, a dispenser must query the PDMP database prior to dispensing a controlled substance in schedules II-V.
