Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Use

Effective Date(s): 7-5-2022

Details:

Requires a provider prescribing a controlled substance in Nebraska to a Medicaid client to check the PDMP before prescribing a Schedule II medication and at dosage adjustment. A provider may delegate checking of the PDMP to a delegate.
