Enrollment Mandates

Dispenser - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment

Effective Date(s): November 1, 2015

Details:

ALL prescribers with a state Controlled Dangerous Substance (CDS) registration (i.e. - those who are authorized to prescribe controlled medications) SHALL register for the NJPMP. Dispensers who dispense CDS.

Use Mandates

Dispenser - Mandatory PDMP Use Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Use

Effective Date(s): November 1, 2015; January 17, 2023

Details:

Prescribers - prior to initial issuance of a prescription for ANY schedule opioid or benzodiazepine; and no less frequently than quarterly thereafter. Dispensers - ONLY if they suspect the patient is acquiring the medication for abuse, misuse or diversion
