Dispenser - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Enrollment

Effective Date(s): March 27, 2018 (statute; practitioners must register by July 1, 2018); April 5, 2018 (regulation)

Prescribes with Oregon licensure and active DEA. Dispensers - Exemptions include: state and federal correctional facility pharmacies, inpatient pharmacies (hospital, in-patient care facilities), Long Term Care pharmacies, student health center pharmacies,

### **Use Mandates**

Prescriber - Mandatory PDMP Use

Effective Date(s): October 1, 2021

Details:

Pharmacists with authority to prescribe pseudoephedrine products must query the PDMP prior to issuing such a prescription.OAR 410-120-1260(13) Enrolled providers are required to check the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP), as defined in ORS
