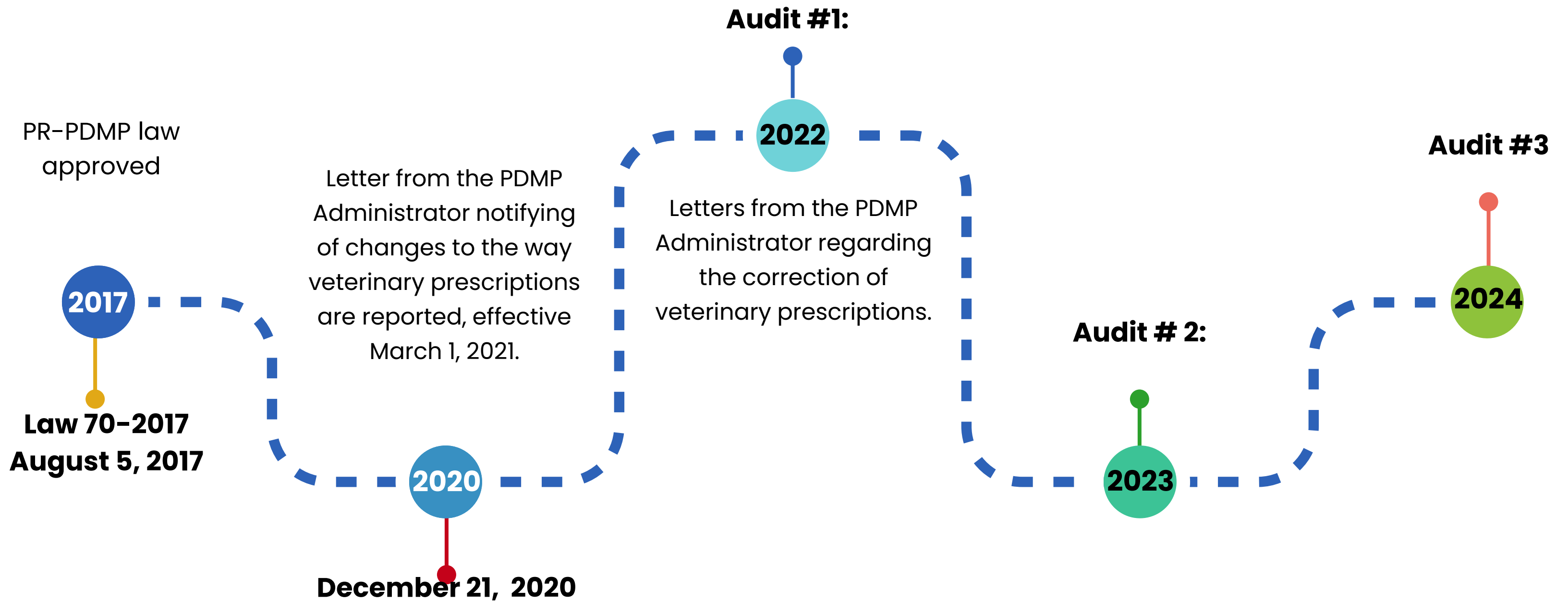

Veterinary Prescriptions in Puerto Rico PDMP

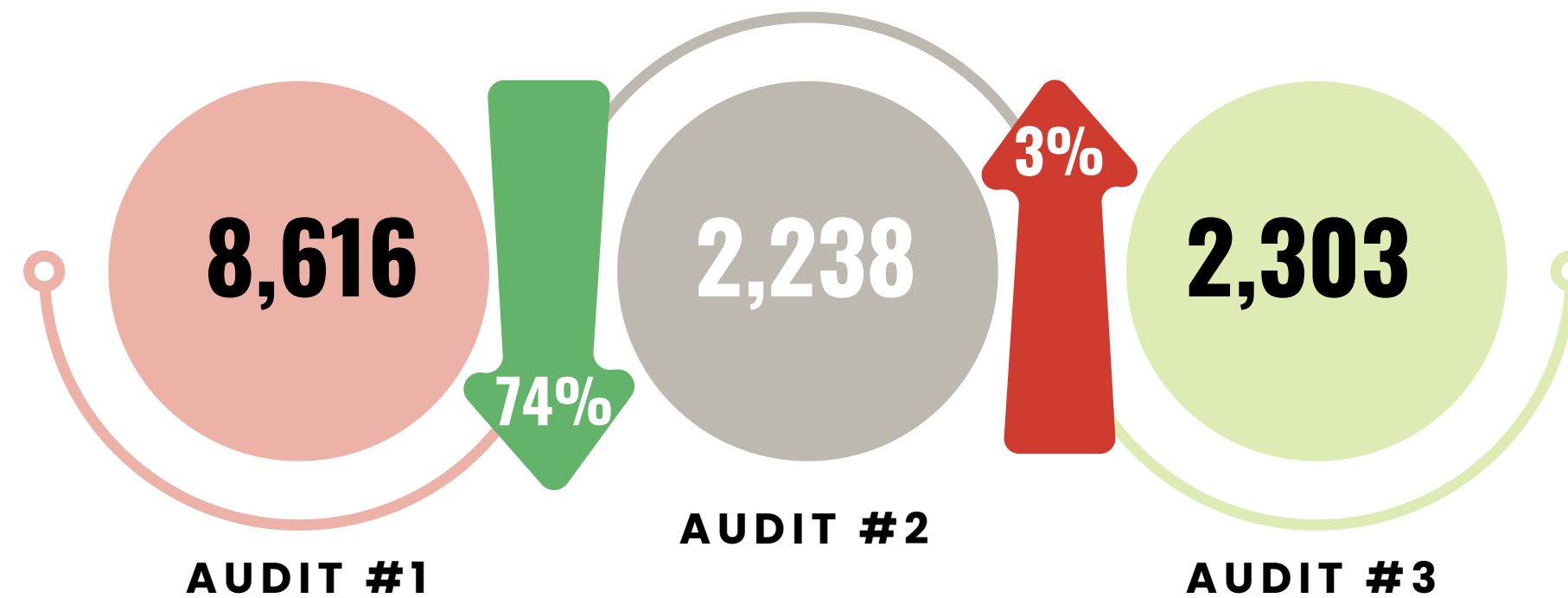

AUDIT RESULTS

VETERINARY PRESCRIPTIONS **INCORRECTLY** REPORTED



AMONG THE **MOST COMMON** ERRORS FOUND ARE:

- Prescription not reported as veterinary
- Submit the prescription with the pet's name instead of the owner's name
- Submit the prescription with the pet's DOB instead of the owner's



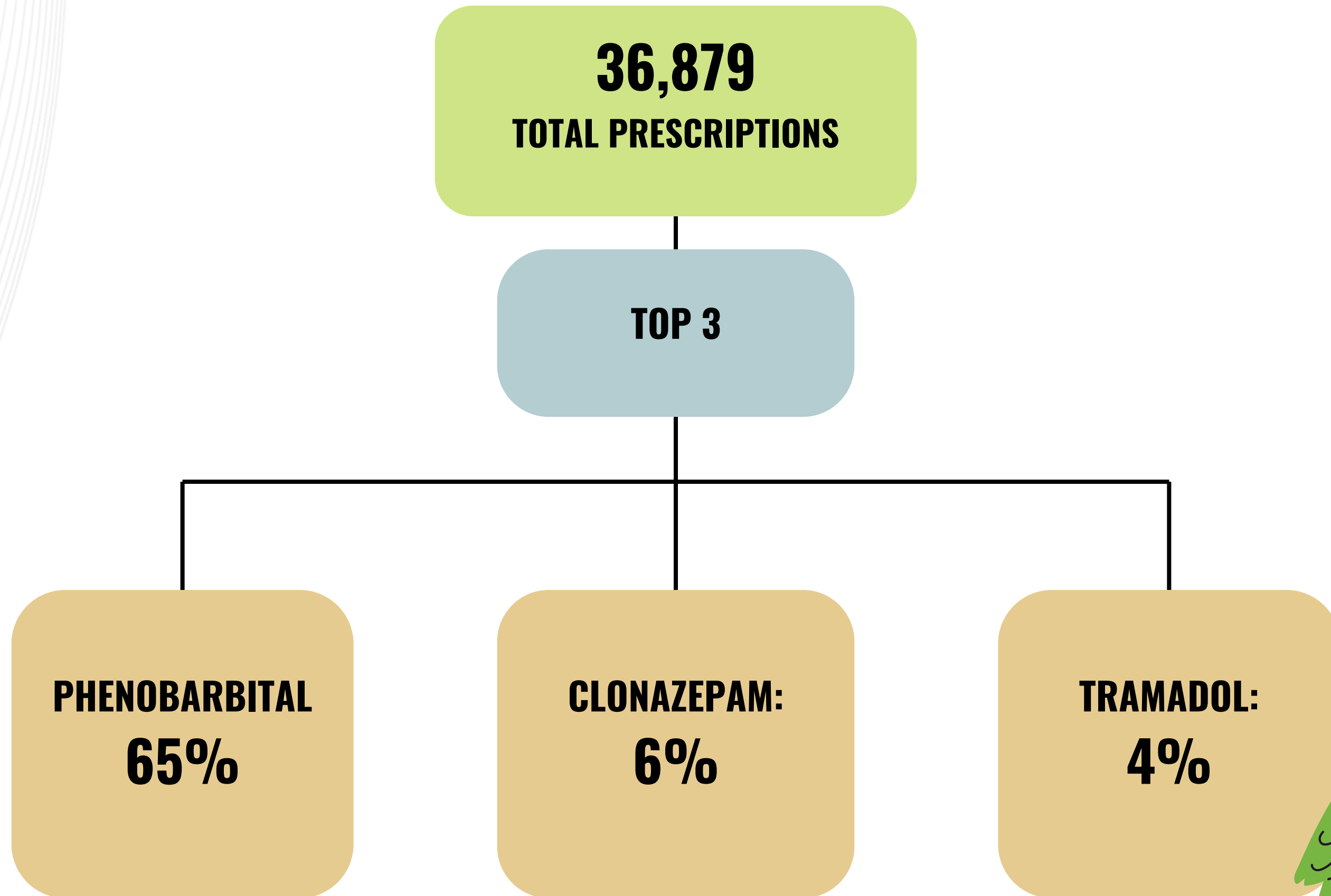

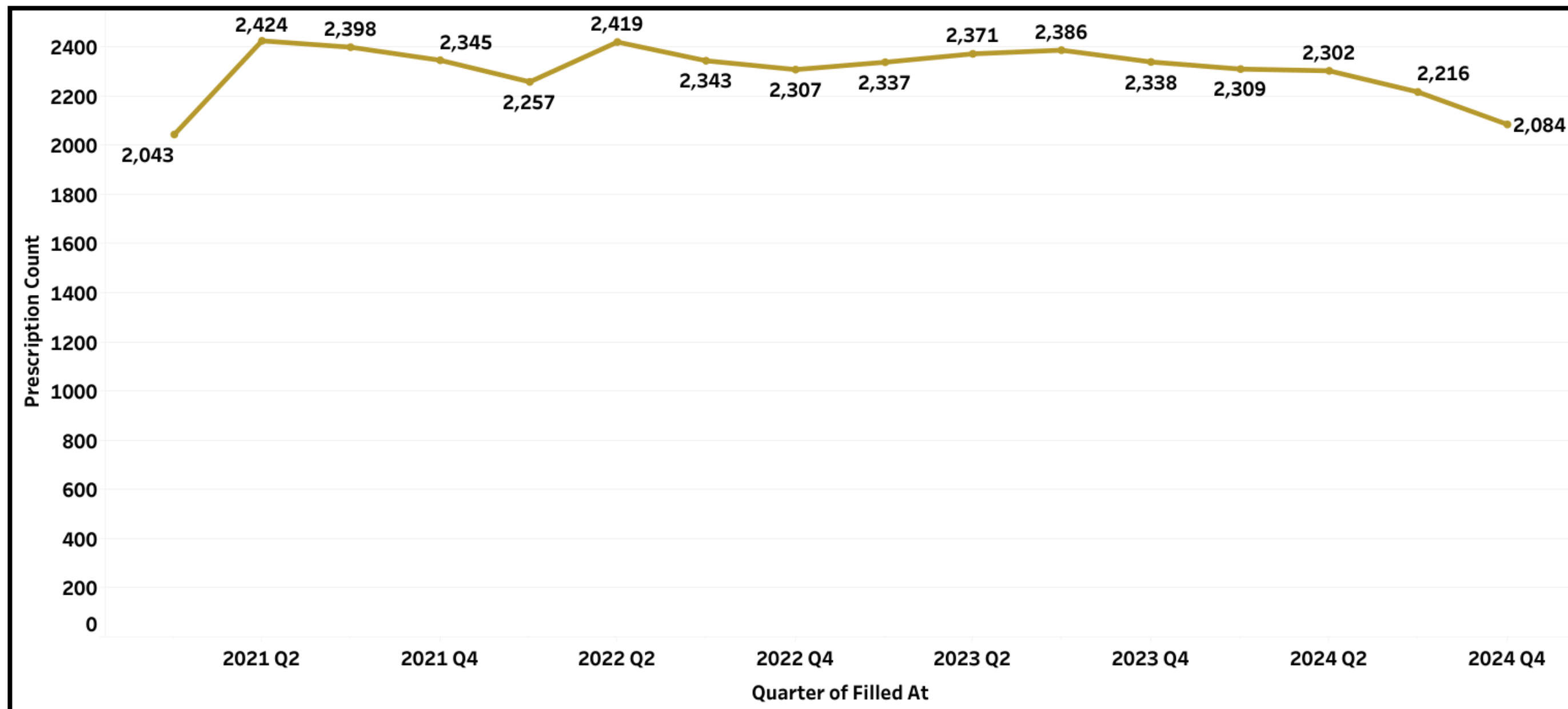

Veterinary Prescription Trends in Puerto Rico

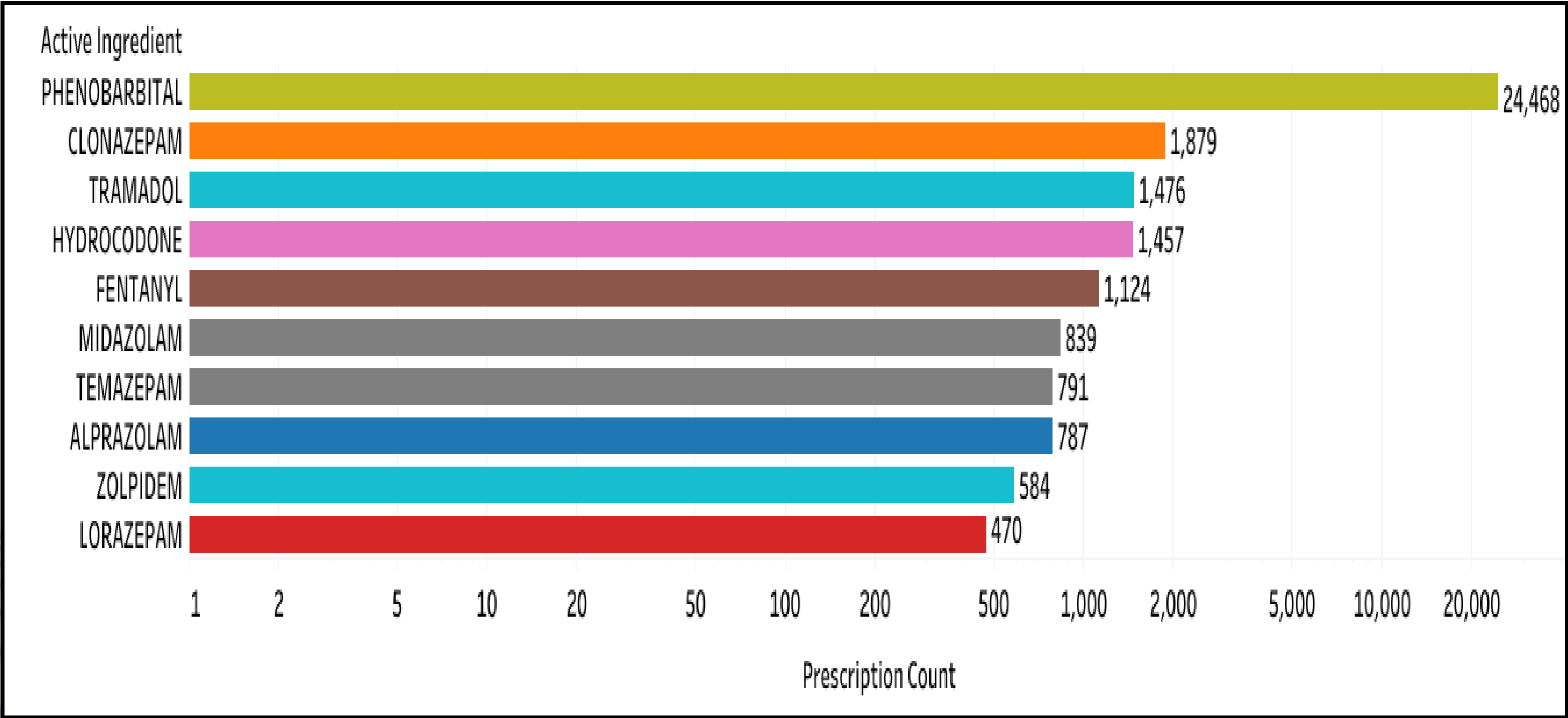
Between 2021 and 2024, a total of 38,879 veterinary dispensations have been reported. A downward trend is observed between 2023 and 2024, but overall, it is a stable trend.

Veterinary prescriptions dispensed by quarter (2021-2024)

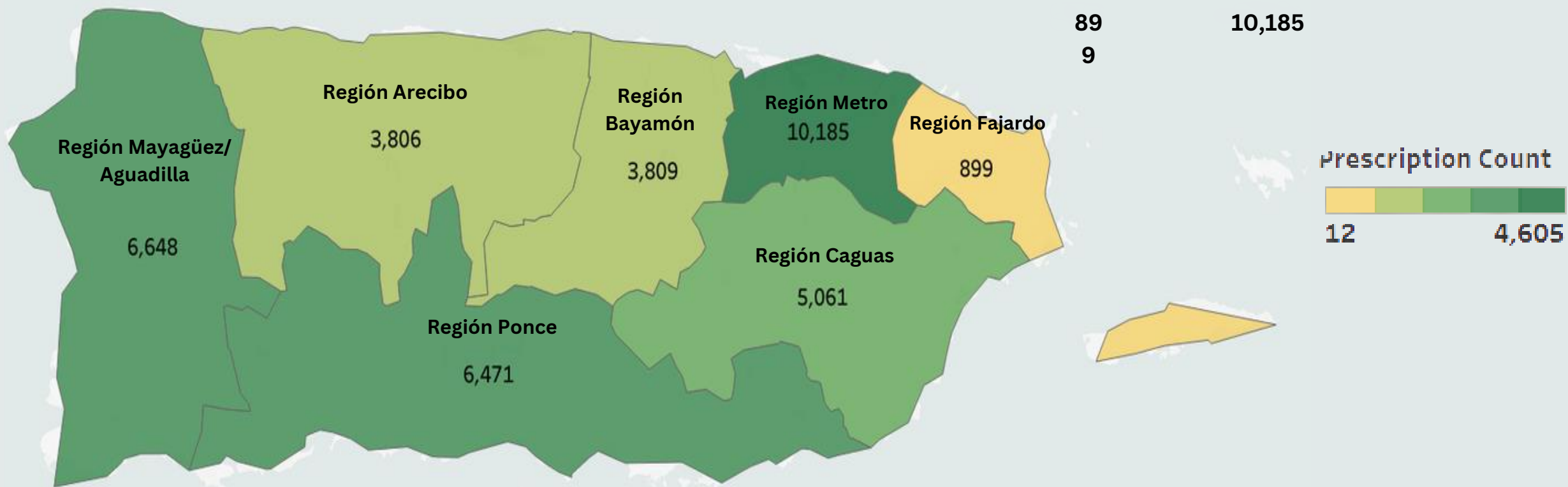
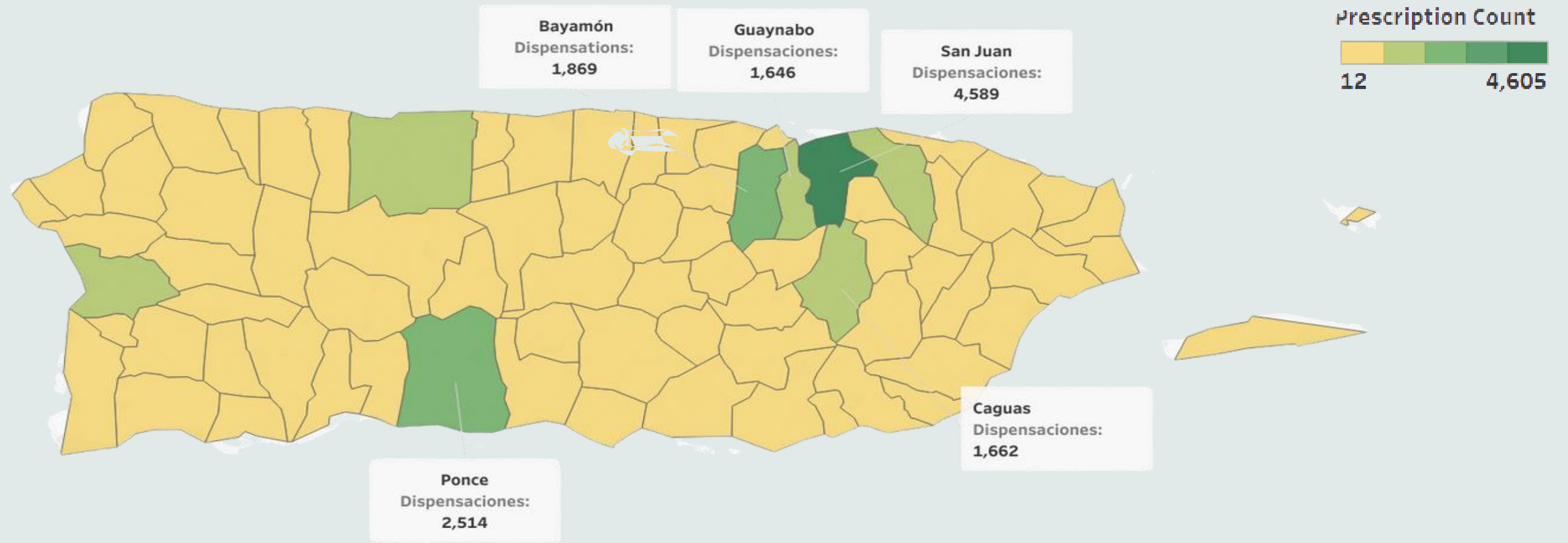


Note: Data presented are for calendar years. This analysis was performed using data reported to the PDMP.
