### Recommendation: Tiered approach to compliance

- Three Tiers
  - Tier 1– Meets a minimum number of compliance requirements
  - Tier 2– Meets more compliance requirements than Tier 1, but not all
  - Tier 3– Meets all compliance requirements
- Tiers to be defined for each approved standard
- Some standards may not lend themselves to “partial” compliance, and therefore may only have Tier 3. Tier 1 and Tier 2 would not be defined in this case.

Chad Garner (OH) reviewed previous work of subcommittee and explained the tiered approach.

### ➤ Subcommittee Goal #1 Apply approved process to determine approval tiers for new schemas

Chad Garner (OH) stated that this group needs to develop the tiers for the 3 new schemas passed by the PMIX Executive Committee. He suggested that the tiers be time-based and related to number of PDMPs that have migrated to the new request/response schemas. Tier 1 would be the PDMP has original schemas implemented. Tier 3 would be the PDMP has implemented the new schema. When majority of states are at Tier 3, then set timeframe (30 days) for remaining PDMPs to be compliant. Jean Hall (KY) asked what to do if a PDMP is at Tier 3 with one hub and Tier 1 with another hub. Chad Garner (OH) stated that PDMPs may need to be able to accommodate both schemas at one time if one PDMP has not adopted the new schema. Katie Moran (Bamboo Health) indicated that PMPi Gateway is not backwards compatible and can not handle both old and new schemas at same time. Jean Hall (KY) stated that their system was modified to handle both old and new schemas with the request/response header. Craig Wetzberger (Bamboo Health) stated that it is not an issue with PMPi Gateway; it does not impact the hubs, but may impact the PDMPs. Chad Garner (OH) recommended that we include some technical resources to participate in this subcommittee to help.
